[the day before today]

We talked yesterday about her problem.

### **yet**

[(1) at some time before now; (2) now; (3) at this time; (4) however]

Have they arrived yet? (1)

Do not sit down yet. (2)

I cannot tell you about it yet. (3)

The sun was shining, yet it was cold. (4)

### **you**

[the person or persons being spoken to]

I am glad to see you.

### **young**

[(1) in the early years of life; (2) not old]

The young girl missed her mother. (1)

He seemed too young to know so much. (2)
